3 Dining Room





1 Classrooms
Collective Cost for Three Classrooms: \$141,854.79
 A dedicated space for training and educational purposes. Important life skills training will take place in the classrooms. One of the main uses for the space will be for Workforce Development Training to ensure our program participants and those in the community who are underemployed or unemployed due to a criminal record learn job skills and connect with second-chance employers.

2 Office
Cost: \$160,845.03
 Social science research indicates that supportive relationships transform lives more than programming. Staff members will use this space to work at Restoration Village to ensure that the residents will have on-site support for ongoing needs.

3 Culinary Arts
Cost: \$114,399.02 Equipment Cost: \$50,000
 The state-of-the-art commercial kitchen is equipped with modern facilities that provide program participants with the necessary tools to acquire culinary arts skills that will be transferable to their future. With proper equipment and training, participants can gain practical knowledge and hands-on experience.

4 Event Space
Cost: \$465,146.43
 The Event Space will double as a chapel and serve as a hub for JUMPSTART community events, chapel services, and large classes. We will use the space to hold interactive program tours, monthly game nights we call Gatherings, graduation ceremonies, and more.

5 Covered Patio
Cost: \$125,000
 The covered patio will provide a welcoming space for participants to gather and connect with one another as they transition back into society. They can enjoy fresh air and a change of scenery, making use of the space for quiet time, fellowship, reflection, and relaxation.
